### **Responsibilities**

- Conduct targeted research and preparatory work including: policy briefings, memorandums, presentations, op-eds, and blog posts
- Assist with content development for organization leadership and staff
- Perform background research and assist in drafting of issue briefs and white papers
- Compile and interpret statistics and other information from public sources
- Manage communication with other policy organizations

- Note: because we are a small team, the analyst will also spend 2-3 hours/week on tasks that are administrative in nature (e.g., managing our mail chimp list, compiling social media analytics)

### **Must-Have Skills & Attributes**

- **Quantitative skills**
  - Can quickly analyze complex education data sets using Excel and/or other descriptive statistic software and report conclusions and trends accurately;
  - Inquisitive about using data to better understand policy outcomes and self-motivated to probe facts and figures to learn more;
  - Understands and can apply basic descriptive and inferential statistics concepts (e.g., normal vs. skewed distributions; percentile ranks; statistical significance) and research methodology.
- **Highly proficient in writing**, ability to adapt style for length and intended audience.
- **Willing and able to search for relevant content and to dive deeply into primary source material.**
- **Highly organized and detail-oriented**
- **Interpersonal skills** to deliver excellent customer service, coordination and integration of work with other team members
- **Strong knowledge of education reform and commitment to our mission and policy priorities**
- **Strong commitment to racial and social justice\**
- Self-motivated and able to work autonomously and follow through on tasks in a virtual office environment

- B.A. required; MA is a plus, especially in public policy or related field
- Prior work experience in education policy
